



East Longmeadow Recreation Department Parent Code of Conduct

I pledge to be fully responsible for my words and actions while attending practices and games and ensure that my behavior adheres to the following code of conduct as established by the Town of East Longmeadow Recreation Department:

- I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, official, staff person, volunteer or any other attendee; and I will not encourage my child or any other individual to engage in unsportsmanlike conduct either.
- I will not engage in any behavior that could endanger the health, safety or well-being of any individual; and I will not encourage my child to engage in any behavior that could endanger the welfare of another individual.
- I will not use profanity and I will not encourage my child or any individual to use profanity.
- I will treat every coach, parent, player, official, spectator, staff person and volunteer with respect regardless of race, creed, national origin or sexual orientation and will encourage my child to do the same.
- I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or attack one's character or integrity in any capacity (this expectation is for coaches, parents, players, officials, spectators, staff persons or volunteers) and I will encourage my child to do the same.
- I will not use drugs, alcohol or tobacco products while attending practices or games and will not permit my child to use them either.

I hereby agree that if I fail to adhere to the conduct established above while attending any practice, game or function related to the youth sports program I may be subject to disciplinary action including, but not limited to, the following:

- Verbal warning issued by the Recreation Department.
- Written warning issued by the Recreation Department.
- Immediate dismissal from the facility for inappropriate conduct.
- Suspended from attending practices, games or program functions for a specified period of time as designated by the program.
- Life-long banishment from the program.
